# What does the text say?

What are the two different questions Jesus asks His disciples? (vv. 27, 29)

What are the different answers to this question? What is the *right* answer? (vv. 28-29; see also Matthew 16:15 and Luke 9:20)

After Peter gave the right answer to Jesus' question, he went and said something really foolish. What was that? (vv. 31-32; see also Matthew 16:22)

#### What does the text mean?

Why is there only one right answer to the question of who Jesus is? (See Acts 4:12; John 3:36; 1 Timothy 2:5-6)

What would Peter have gained if he would have been able to prevent Jesus' suffering and death? What would he have lost? (Luke 9:25-27; 1 Corinthians 15:16-19; Galatians 2:20-21)

#### What does the text do?

There are going to be many times when we say foolish things about God and His work through Jesus Christ. How do we find out when we've been foolish? What do we do after we found that we've been foolish?
