A Discipling Community in Mission

Take a good look at this girl. She works and plays on a desert wadi. She speaks Chadian Arabic. She's spunky. She's fun. And... she's a daughter of

Ishmael. Yet, she knows neither the living God of Abraham, Ishmael's father, nor the truth about Abraham's distant child of promise, Jesus of Nazareth.

But shouldn't she? Did not the crucified God suffer for her? Will she be included in the human throng from every tribe and tongue who shall surround the throne of the Lamb with praises of his worthiness (Rev. 5:9-10)? Shall she be made glad, finding her source of new life and heavenly citizenship in Zion (Psalm 87)? God only knows.

Nevertheless, this girl lives where people of other tribes possess this good news for her. They are black Africans, not of Arab blood. They live in the south of her country. Some of these southerners were brought to faith and educated for Christian ministry by our own Mission. But, in large, the vast needs of the southerners' own tribes and language groups have captured their attention. And rightly so.

But, on the other hand, it has been difficult for southerners to go north with love, confidence and culturally appropriate ways of carrying the good news to northern peoples, at least without creating culturally southern churches. Fears, prejudices and suspicions from an age-old corporate memory of being considered inferior haunt them, and the strange world of Islam appears formidable.

So, as the "mother church" and mission, how shall we help? After years of reflection, discussion and prayer concerning the on-going educational needs of the southern church as well as our own Mission's thrust to unreached peoples, three specific areas of ministry have been identified for us to consider: 1) to work with southern national ministers and their families in order to do mission together, all the while further equipping them with spiritual, family and theological formation; 2) to be available for the continuing theological education of our own missionaries on the field; and 3) to provide a community for the discipling of new converts from Muslim backgrounds.

So, how to do it? Young people have visions, old(er) have dreams. So says the Scripture. Teresa and I are now old(er)! And we have a dream.

We're dreaming of a community of expatriate missionaries and nationals together, one where discipling in spiritual, theological and family life takes place, one embedded near unreached people for the sake of mission. We're dreaming of a radically different model of education, a pedagogy not determined by the western classroom but by the relational and oral dynamics that make Africa Africa.

We're dreaming of a ministry shaped by the grace manifest in the hidden life of Christ at Nazareth. There, in view of later, more public ministry, Jesus embarked upon mission by first growing in wisdom and in favor with God and his neighbors (Lk 2:52).

Does this model not answer to the needs we want to address in the formation of nationals (and ourselves!)? Does it not give us a guide—the Incarnation of Christ, the missionary—for embedding ourselves among the unreached in order to love them and gain, with time, the right to be heard? Did Christ not employ these same dynamics in the training of the Twelve?

Look again at this girl in the picture. Where do you think she lives? In Nazareth! For, in a sense, any unreached community is a Nazareth. Nazareths await the coming of God's mission and missionaries, and yes, through grace something good can come out of Nazareth. *Paul Szobody*


This evening the 5th Act Church Planting team will be meeting with the Regional Pastors and other CLB leaders to continue the planning and funding of a new urban church plant.
