Bringing **FATH** Home

1 John 1:5–10

What does the text say?

How is Light and Darkness talked about when it comes to us and God? (vv. 5-7)

How is it that we might deceive ourselves? (vv. 8, 10)

How then do we walk in the light and practice the truth? (v. 9)

What does the text mean?

Why is it so important to recognize that God is nothing but Light? (v. 8; Psalm 7:11; Exodus 20:5; Numbers 14:18–19)

Why do you need to confess that you are sinful? (v. 9; 1 Timothy 1:15; Galatians 6:12–16; Psalm 130:3–4)

The call to “walk in the light” can sound an awful lot like a commandment to do righteous works. What is John *really* saying here? (vv. 8-10; John 12:35–36, 45-48; Ephesians 5:13–14)

What does the text do?

Standing in the Light of God both exposes your sinfulness and shows Christ as your atonement for sin. Think of a time when God’s light has shown you your sin and then immediately proclaimed the Cross of Christ to you.
