What does the text mean?

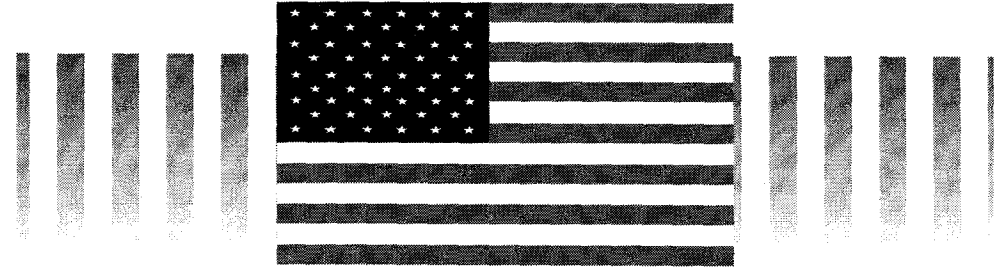
